### *SAMANVAYA meeting of Coordinators*

Two days Samanvay training was organized by MPSSS for field staffs of DSSSs on 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> June 2018. The Samanvay training focused on locating and focusing on nutritional outcomes of sustainable agriculture. Resource persons from Vikas Samvad explained identifying malnourished children, underlying factors of malnourishment and community based management of malnutrition. They also explained food mapping as a tool to be used in community to identify availability of food in villages



and developing perspective to diversified food consumption. Along with this they explained few nutrition and health based government schemes that can be monitored in the field.

### *State level collaboration meeting with Government Officials*

19<sup>th</sup> June 2018 State level collaboration meeting was held with Government Official at Pastoral Centre,



Bhopal. The keynote address was given by the Chief Guest of the programme Ramesh Kumar Shrivastava Chief Advisor to Neeti Ayog Madhya Pradesh. He shared primary information about Neeti Ayog, that it is focusing on Transformation of Aspirational Districts' programme which aims to quickly and effectively transform 150 districts of India. Individual States are the main drivers; this program will focus on the strength of each district, identify low-hanging

fruits for immediate improvement, measure progress, and rank districts. Health & Nutrition, Education, Agriculture & Water Resources, Financial Inclusion & Skill Development, and Basic Infrastructure are this programme's core areas of focus.
